

Human Trafficking: National Referral Mechanism Statistics – July to September 2015

Key points

- During the period July to September 2015 there were 839 referrals to the National Referral Mechanism (NRM), comprising individuals from 66 countries of origin.
- As at 04/01/2016, 196 of the 839 people referred to the NRM during this quarter received a 'positive conclusive' decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked.
- 30 of the 839 people referred to the NRM were still awaiting a 'reasonable grounds' decision. 406 of the 839 people referred were still awaiting a conclusive decision.
- 29 people were referred from Northern Ireland, 50 from Scotland and 38 from Wales. The remaining 722 were referred in England.

National Referral Mechanism Statistics – July to September 2015

This report has been primarily provided to inform the Home Office Modern Slavery Unit of the UK's delivery against a number of definitive requirements contained in the Council of Europe Convention on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings. Reports are produced for each quarter; the previous report (0225-UKHTC) included statistics from April to June 2015 and was published in December 2015.

It is important to note that the number of referrals outlined in this report is not a measure of human trafficking in the UK; rather it indicates the number of individuals who have been referred in to the system as potential victims of modern slavery or human trafficking.

Data base

The information in this report is obtained from referrals made to the National Referral Mechanism (NRM) for the three month period from July to September 2015. The data used is correct as at 04/01/2016. It should be noted that the data used is a 'snapshot in time' and there are decisions on trafficking status yet to be made.

The data cut-off date for this report is 04/01/2016.

Introduction

- 1. On 01/04/2009 the UK adopted a National Referral Mechanism (NRM), which is a process to identify individuals who may be potential victims of trafficking (PVoT) and provide them with the protection and support to which they are entitled under the Council of Europe Convention on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings.
- 2. The process starts when a designated 'first responder' refers a potential victim of trafficking to one of two separate, but linked, UK Competent Authorities: the Home Office UK Visas and Immigration Department and the National Crime Agency UK Human Trafficking Centre. The process has two stages, 'Reasonable Grounds' and 'Conclusive Decision', during which trained staff assess all available information in reaching a decision as to whether or not the individual is a victim of human trafficking.
- 3. This report contains data derived wholly from information supplied by the NRM. The data only reflects potential victims of trafficking referred into the NRM and cannot be taken as a definitive situation report on human trafficking into, within or out of the UK. Potential victims of trafficking may not be referred to the NRM for a number of reasons and therefore would not feature within this report.
- 4. Details for referrals from first responders for the UK are contained in the tables after each summary of adult and minor referrals in the main text. Details for referrals from first responders in England are contained in Annex D; the 722 referrals represent 86% of the total UK referrals. Northern Ireland is contained in Annex E; the 29 referrals represent 3% of the total UK referrals. Details for referrals from first responders in Scotland are contained in Annex F; the 50 referrals represent 6% of the total UK referrals. Details for referrals from first responders in Wales are contained in Annex G; the 38 referrals represent 5% of the total UK referrals.

¹ The NRM Oversight Board has a prescribed list of organisations that may act as first responder and can refer individuals to the NRM. This list currently contains police officers, NCA, Home Office, Social Services and a number of non-government organisations (NGOs).

² The Competent Authorities have a target date of five working days from receipt of referral in which to make a decision. The test that is applied is whether the statement 'I suspect but cannot prove...' would be true and whether a reasonable person would be of the opinion that, having regard to the information available, there were reasonable grounds to believe the individual concerned had been trafficked.

³ The Competent Authorities have a target date of 45 calendar days from the reasonable grounds decision to make a Conclusive Decision on the individual's victim status having gathered further information. The test that is applied is whether on the balance of probabilities 'It is more likely than not...' that the individual was trafficked based on the information available.

Breakdown of All (Adult and Minor)⁴ Referrals by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 5. During the three month period July to September 2015, there were 839 referrals of adults and minors to the NRM. These referrals comprise individuals from 66 countries of origin. The table below shows the 10 most frequently referred countries of origin, which account for 588 (70%) of all referrals⁵.
- 6. As at 04/01/2016, the most common countries of origin for people referred were Albania (134), Vietnam (117), Nigeria (63), Poland (53) and United Kingdom (47).
- 7. The most common countries of origin for people referred during this period who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process were Albania (117), Vietnam (85), Nigeria (54), Poland (47), and United Kingdom (44).
- 8. 196 (23%) of the 839 people referred to the NRM during this period received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for people who received a positive conclusive decision were Poland (44), United Kingdom (38), Romania (21), Bulgaria (15) and Slovakia (10).
- 9. 30 (4%) of the 839 people referred to the NRM during this period are still awaiting a reasonable grounds decision. The most common countries of origin for people who had not received a reasonable grounds decision were Albania (10), Vietnam (6), China (3) and Nigeria (3).
- 10. 406 (48%) of the 839 people referred to the NRM during this period are yet to receive a conclusive decision. The most common countries of origin for people who had not received a conclusive decision were Albania (100), Vietnam (61), Nigeria (47), Eritrea (30) and Sudan (25).

Breakdown of Adults by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 11. There were 599 adult referrals to the NRM during this period, comprising individuals from 60 countries of origin. The table below shows the 10 most referred countries of origin, which account for 415 (69%) of all adult referrals⁶.
- 12. The most common countries of origin for adults referred this quarter were Albania (91), Vietnam (59), Poland (52), Nigeria (47) and Romania (39).
- 13. 495 (83%) of the 599 adult referrals received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive grounds process. The most common countries of origin were Albania (83), Poland (47), Nigeria (41), Vietnam (41) and Sudan (34).
- 14. 155 (26%) of the 599 adult referrals received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for adults who obtained a positive conclusive decision were Poland (44), Romania (21), Bulgaria (15), United Kingdom (14) and Hungary, Slovakia and Lithuania (9 each).

Breakdown of Adult Referrals by Exploitation Type and Gender, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 15. The breakdown of exploitation types for the 599 adults who were referred this period were labour exploitation 249 (42%), sexual exploitation 215 (36%) and domestic servitude 81 (13%). The type of exploitation was unknown for 54 (9%) of adults referred. Of these 599, 340 (57%) were female and 259 (43%) were male.
- 16. Labour exploitation (195) was the most common exploitation type for adults referred during this period who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive grounds process, closely followed by sexual exploitation (194). Labour exploitation (103) was also the most common type for adults who received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked.

Breakdown of Adult Referrals by Exploitation Type and Age Range, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 17. Of the 599 adults referred, the largest age group represented were 21-30 year olds who comprised 267 (45%) of all adults referred this period. This age group was also the most prevalent for adults who received a positive conclusive decision (57).
- 18. The age group 21-30 was the most prevalent across all exploitation types; labour and sexual exploitation and domestic servitude.

Breakdown of Minors by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 19. 240 minors were referred to the NRM this quarter, comprising individuals from 35 countries of origin. The table below shows the 11 most frequently referred countries of origin, which account for 196 (82%) of all child referrals⁸.
- 20. The most common countries of origin for referred minors were Vietnam (58), Albania (43), United Kingdom (31), Nigeria (16) and Eritrea (13).
- 21. 184 (77%) of the 240 minor referrals received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process. The most common countries of origin were Vietnam (44), Albania (34), United Kingdom (29), Nigeria (13) and Eritrea (11).
- 22. 41 (17%) of the 240 minors referred to the NRM this period received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for minors who obtained a positive conclusive decision were United Kingdom (24), Vietnam (4) and Czech Republic (4).

Breakdown of Minor Referrals by Exploitation Type and Gender, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

- 23. The exploitation types for the 240 minors who were referred were labour exploitation (62), sexual exploitation (60), domestic servitude (20) and one referral for organ harvesting. The exploitation type for 97 was unknown⁹. Of these 240 minors, 140 (58%) were males and 100 (42%) were females.
- 24. The most common exploitation type, where known, for minors who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process was labour exploitation (55).
- 25. The most common exploitation type for minors who received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked was sexual exploitation (29), accounting for 71% of the 41 minors receiving a positive conclusive decision.

Breakdown of Minor Referrals by Exploitation Type and Age Range, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

26. The age range 16-17 years old was the most common for minors at the time of referral, which comprised of 115 (48%) of all referred minors. The age range 12-15 years was the most common for minors granted a positive conclusive decision and comprised of 19 minors.
