Key points

- During the period July to September 2014 there were 631 referrals¹ to the NRM, comprising individuals from 62 countries of origin.
- As at 02/01/2015, 162 of the 631 people referred to the NRM received a 'positive conclusive' decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked.
- 11 of the 631 people referred to the NRM were still awaiting a 'reasonable grounds' decision. 273 of the 631 people referred were still awaiting a conclusive decision.
- 31 people were referred from Northern Ireland, 29 from Scotland and 21 from Wales. The remaining 550 were referred in England.

Adults and minors

National Referral Mechanism Statistics – July to September 2014

This report has been primarily provided to inform the National Referral Mechanism Oversight Board of the UK's delivery against a number of definitive requirements contained in the Council of Europe Convention on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings. Reports are produced for each quarter; the previous report (0110-UKHTC) included statistics from April to June 2014 and was published in October 2014.

It is important to note that the number of referrals outlined in this report is not a measure of human trafficking in the UK; rather it indicates the number of individuals who have been referred as potential victims of human trafficking.

Data base

The information in this report is obtained from referrals made to the National Referral Mechanism (NRM) for the three month period from July to September 2014. The data used is correct as at 02/01/2015. It should be noted that the data used is a 'snapshot in time' and there are decisions on trafficking status yet to be made.

The data cut-off date for this report is 02/01/2015.

Detail

1. On 01/04/2009 the UK adopted a National Referral Mechanism (NRM), which is a process to identify individuals who may be potential victims of trafficking (PVoT) and provide them with the protection and support to which they are entitled under the Council of Europe Convention on Action against Trafficking in Human Beings.

2. The process starts when a designated 'first responder'² refers a potential victim of trafficking to one of two separate, but linked, UK Competent Authorities: the Home Office UK Visas and Immigration Department and the National Crime Agency UK Human Trafficking Centre. The process has two stages, 'Reasonable

² The NRM Oversight Board has a prescribed list of organisations that may act as first responder and can refer individuals to the NRM. This list currently contains police officers, NCA, Home Office, Social Services and a number of non-government organisations (NGOs).

Grounds^{'³} and 'Conclusive Decision'⁴, during which trained staff assess all available information in reaching a decision as to whether or not the individual is a victim of human trafficking.

3. This report contains data derived wholly from information supplied by the NRM. The data only reflects potential victims of trafficking referred into the NRM and cannot be taken as a definitive situation report on human trafficking into, within or out of the UK. Potential victims of trafficking may not be referred to the NRM for a number of reasons and therefore would not feature within this report.

4. Details for referrals from first responders for the UK are contained in the tables after each summary of adult and minor referrals in the main text. Details for referrals from first responders in England are contained in Annex D; the 550 referrals represent 87% of the total UK referrals. Northern Ireland is contained in Annex E; the 31 referrals represent 5% of the total UK referrals. Details for referrals from first responders in Scotland are contained in Annex F; the 29 referrals represent 5% of the total UK referrals. Details for referrals represent 5% of the total UK referrals for referrals from first responders in Scotland are contained in Annex F; the 29 referrals represent 5% of the total UK referrals. Details for referrals from first responders in Annex G; the 21 referrals represent 3% of the total UK referrals.

³ The Competent Authorities have a target date of five working days from receipt of referral in which to make a decision. The test that is applied is whether the statement 'I suspect but cannot prove...' would be true and whether a reasonable person would be of the opinion that, having regard to the information available, there were reasonable grounds to believe the individual concerned had been trafficked.

⁴ The Competent Authorities have a target date of 45 calendar days from the reasonable grounds decision to make a Conclusive Decision on the individual's victim status having gathered further information. The test that is applied is whether on the balance of probabilities 'It is more likely than not...' that the individual was trafficked based on the information available.

Breakdown of All (Adult and Minor)⁵ Referrals by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

5. During the three month period July to September 2014, there were 631 referrals of adults and minors to the NRM. These referrals comprise individuals from 62 countries of origin. The table below shows the 10 most frequently referred countries of origin, which account for 446 (71%) of all referrals⁶.

6. As at 02/01/2015, the most common countries of origin for people referred were Albania (113), Nigeria (64), Vietnam (60) and Romania (55).

7. The most common countries of origin for people who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process were Albania (102), Nigeria (56), Vietnam (49), Romania (44) and United Kingdom (44).

8. 162 (26%) of the 631 people referred to the NRM received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for people who received a positive conclusive decision were United Kingdom (42), Romania (36), Poland (14) Lithuania (13) and Czech Republic (11).

9. 11 (2%) of the 631 people referred to the NRM had not received a reasonable grounds decision. The most common countries of origin for people who had not received a reasonable grounds decision were Albania (3), Vietnam (2), China (2) and Nigeria (2).

10. 273 (43%) of the 631 people referred to the NRM had not received a conclusive decision. The most common countries of origin for people who had not received a conclusive decision were Albania (79), Nigeria (45), Vietnam (30) and China (18).

Breakdown of Adults by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

11. There were 463 adult referrals, comprising individuals from 51 countries of origin. The table below shows the 10 most referred countries of origin, which account for 318 (69%) of all adult referrals⁷.

12. The most common countries of origin for adults referred were Albania (71), Nigeria (51) and Romania (46).

13. 385 (83%) of the 463 adult referrals received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive grounds process. The most common countries of origin were Albania (66), Nigeria (44) and Romania (36).

14. 127 (27%) of the 463 adult referrals received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for adults who obtained a positive conclusive decision were Romania (29), United Kingdom (22), Poland (14), Lithuania (12) and Czech Republic (11).

Breakdown of Adult Referrals by Exploitation Type and Gender, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

15. The breakdown of exploitation types for the 463 adults who were referred were labour exploitation 167 (36%), sexual exploitation 166 (36%), and domestic servitude 72 (16%). The type of exploitation was unknown for 58 (12%) of adults referred. Of these, 292 (63%) were females 170 (37%) were males, and 1 adult (<1%) was recorded as transgender.

16. Sexual exploitation (149) was the most common exploitation type for adults who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive grounds process. Labour exploitation (84) was the most common type for adults who received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked.

Breakdown of Adult Referrals by Exploitation type and Age Range, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

17. Of the 463 adults referred, the largest age group represented were 21-30 year olds who comprised 200 (43%) of those referred. This age group was also the most prevalent for people who received a positive conclusive decision (46).

18. The age group 21-30 was also the most prevalent across all exploitation types.

Breakdown of Minors by Country of Origin, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision (CD)

19. 168 minors were referred to the NRM, comprising individuals from 33 countries of origin. The table below shows the 12 most frequently referred countries of origin, which account for 143 (85%) of all child referrals⁹.

20. The most common countries of origin for referred minors were Albania (42), Vietnam (30), United Kingdom (22) and Nigeria (13).

21. 139 (83%) of the 168 minor referrals received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process. The most common countries of origin were Albania (36), Vietnam (29) and United Kingdom (22).

22. 35 (21%) of the 168 minors referred to the NRM received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked. The most common countries of origin for minors who obtained a positive conclusive decision were United Kingdom (20), Romania (7) and Vietnam (3).

Breakdown of Minor Referrals by Exploitation Type and Gender, by Reasonable Grounds (RG) Decision and Conclusive Decision

23. The exploitation types for the 168 minors who were referred were labour exploitation (48), sexual exploitation (42), domestic servitude (14) and one reporting organ harvesting. The exploitation type for 63 was unknown¹⁰. Of these 168 minors 77 (46%) were females and 91 (54%) were males.

24. The most common exploitation type, where known, for minors who received a positive reasonable grounds decision and were therefore submitted to the conclusive decision process was labour exploitation (47).

25. The most common exploitation type for minors who received a positive conclusive decision and were therefore found to have been trafficked was sexual exploitation, accounting for 20 (57%) of the 35 minors receiving a positive conclusive decision.

¹⁰ The exploitation type is shown as unknown where individuals have been encountered prior to the exploitation beginning but where there were indicators that there was an intention to exploit.

26. The age range 16-17 years old was the most common for minors at the time of referral which comprised of 90 (54%) of all referred minors. The age range 16-17 years was the most common for minors granted a positive conclusive decision and comprised of 19 minors.
